

Catholic Healthcare West Unites In China Basin

November 1-7, 2000 - Catholic Healthcare West is on the move. The not-for-profit organization is consolidating three offices in the San Francisco area into one office in China Basin.

By the new year, its corporate headquarters staff of 130 will leave its 34,000-square-foot office at 1700 Montgomery St. and move into the new 45,000-square-foot facility. The former Bay Area regional office, located in another area of the China Basin complex, will move to that new office. So will employees in the risk services offices that were in Oakland. In all, 145 people will work at the new office at 185 Berry St.

The move, says spokesperson Mark Klein, is in line with the organization's restructuring -- regional offices have been eliminated and savings have been achieved by cutting out redundancies.

By consolidating into one office, CHW will save about \$2.5 million over five years, Klein said.
